Said the VC: "we can see the high

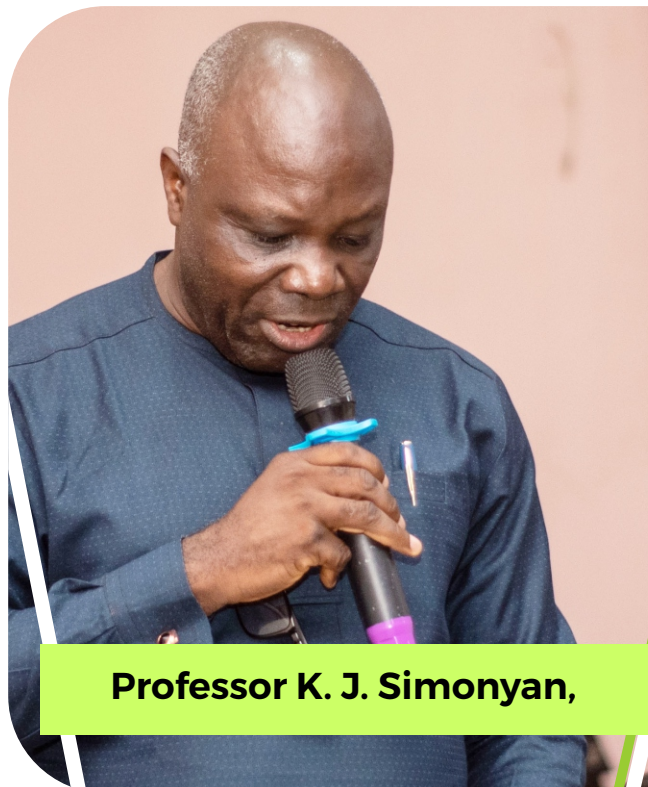
quality of the materials used in renovating this laboratory. Many of us know what it looked like years ago. We now have lab. benches with excellent marble finishing that will stand the test of time.
