VC swears-in new SUG Officials, charges them on transparent leadership as their predecessors

The Vice Chancellor of Michael Okpara University of Agriculture, Umudike (MOUAAU), Prof. Maduebibisi Ofo Iwe, on Thursday, August 21, 2025, swore in the newly elected Students' Union Government (SUG) officials at the Anyim Pius Anyim Auditorium, charging them to embrace transparent leadership and build on the gains of their predecessors.

The swearing-in marked the formal transition from the outgoing SUG administration led by Comrade Fortune Ikpeama to the new executive headed by Comrade Nwogu Bright Addison as President.

Other officials inaugurated include Onuekwusi Precious (Vice President),

Sunday Miracle (Secretary General), Monday Isabella (Assistant Secretary General), Abuchi Emmanuel (Director of Welfare), Innocent Godziller (Director of Socials), Godson Somtochukwu (Director of Finance), Kenora Adaeze (Director of Treasury), Chimaroke Ibeh (Public Relations Officer), Goodluck Ifeanyi (Director of Transport), and Omeonu Uchechukwu (Director of Sports). The Student Representative Council and Judiciary members were also sworn in.

In his speech, Prof. Iwe reminded the new leaders that their election was a call to service and not an opportunity for personal ambition. He emphasized accountability, fairness, and inclusiveness as the pillars of good leadership. "You must remember that the student community entrusted you with this mandate. Lead with honesty, be transparent in

your dealings, and ensure that the welfare of students remains your top priority," the Vice Chancellor said.

He commended the outgoing president, Comrade Ikpeama, for what he described as "a tenure marked by responsibility and cooperation with management," and urged the new administration to consolidate on those achievements.

Responding on behalf of the new executives, Comrade Addison pledged to prioritize the welfare of students, foster unity, and maintain a cordial working relationship with the university management.

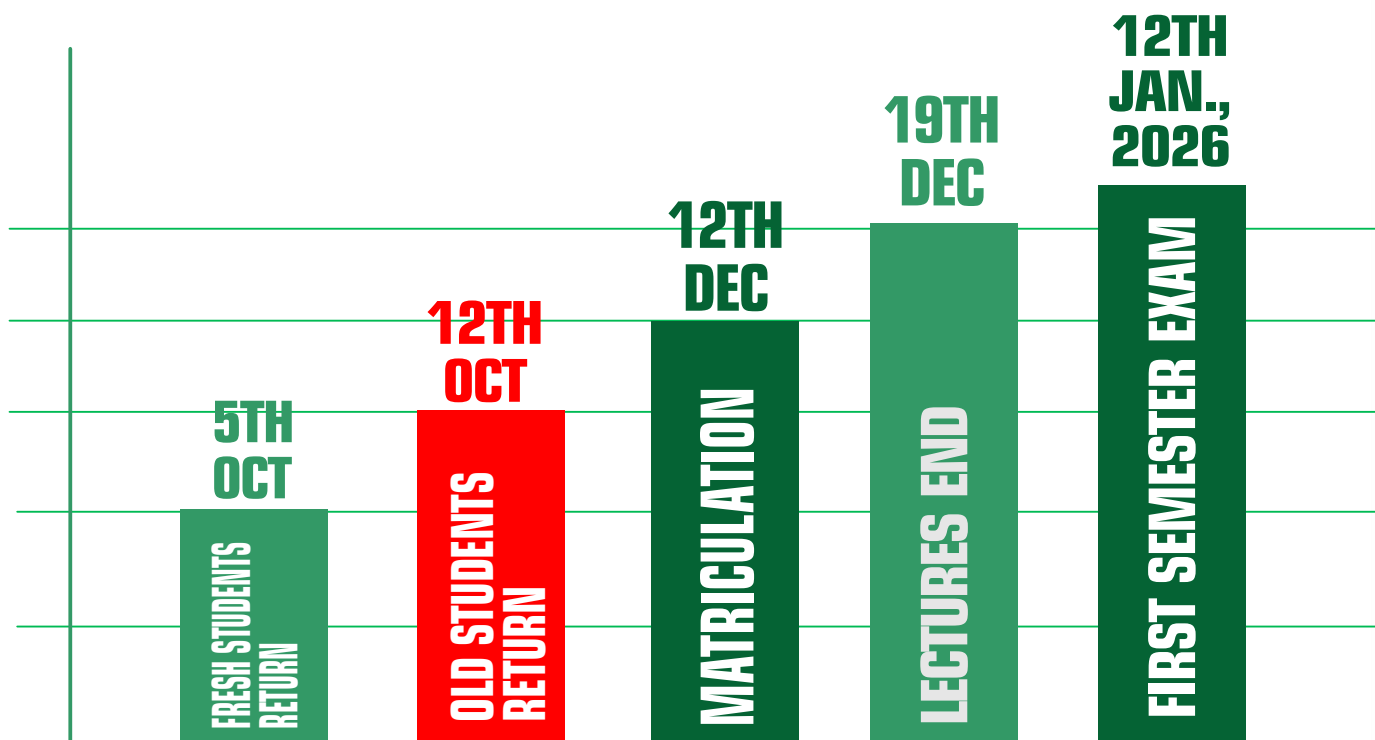

VC announces 2025/2026 Academic Calender, as freshmen resume Oct. 5

The Vice-Chancellor of Michael Okpara University of Agriculture, Umudike (MOUAU), Prof. Maduebibisi Ofo Iwe, has announced that the institution will officially resume academic activities on October 5, 2025, following what he described as a remarkable achievement in stabilising the University's academic calendar.

Prof. Iwe disclosed this during the swearing-in ceremony of the newly elected Students' Union Government (SUG) officials of MOUAU, held on Thursday, August 21, 2025 at the Senator Anyim Pius Anyim Auditorium of the University.

He said the realignment of the calendar has successfully

restored a much-needed balance to the University's schedule, ensuring that staff and students can now enjoy a two-month vacation period before returning to the classroom.

Prof. Iwe explained that this development sets MOUAU apart from many other Nigerian universities that are still struggling to recover from the disruptions caused by strikes and the COVID 19 Pandemic.

According to the VC, "the achievement is a milestone for us as a university community. For the first time in many years, our calendar has been fully stabilized to allow staff and students a well-deserved long vacation".

MOUAU Nerws gathered that the 2025/2026 Academic Calendar

shows that new students are expected to arrive the Campus ob October 5, while returning students would resume on October 12, 2025.

Further more, Lectures for the 1st Semester would begin on October 13 and end on December 19, 2025.

Matriculation ceremony for fresh students is scheduled for December 12, 2025 while the 1st Semester examinations would start on January 12, 2026
